



## VERMONT BEEF PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION

Enclosed is a Waybill which should be filled out and accompany your cattle to Champlain Valley Exposition on delivery day. The day before the sale (Friday).

- Please enter the telephone number we can use to contact you or your trucker Friday morning during delivery in case there are any problems. You can reach us on Friday morning at 802-349-7000
- Your scheduled delivery time is noted on the waybill. Please be as prompt as possible. Early delivery keeps the cattle calm and reduces shrinkage.
- Record the Serial Number and Expiration Date for the vaccine if you want your cattle to sell as “vaccinated.”
- Enter the date that your cattle actually received the vaccine and sign the form.
- Fill in the other information requested – Farm Ear Tag Number, Sex, Date of Birth and Breed.
- If your cattle are “special” in any way that a buyer may pay more, please include a sheet of paper for the auctioneer to read about your cattle. Items of interest are Natural, Organic, No Implants, Closed Herd, No Antibiotics, Born on your farm, etc.
- **We need all animals on site by 9am.** We expect to be finished processing by noon. Animals arriving after we are finished will not be weighed or inspected. *If you are making multiple trips, be sure to plan on having all animals on site by 9am and when you arrive at the penning area, NOTIFY SALE STAFF THAT YOU HAVE MORE LOADS. This is your responsibility, as we can't plan your delivery!*

### NOTE DATE CHANGES!

STOCK DELIVERY DATE – October 14, 2011. SALE DATE October 15, 2011

EARLY REGISTRATION DEADLINE 3 weeks before sale – Postmarked by September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2011

LATE REGISTRATION DEADLINE 2 weeks before sale – Postmarked by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

VACCINATION PERIOD 2 to 5 weeks before sale – Between September 10 and October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

WEANING DEADLINE 2 weeks before sale – October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011

WAYBILLS MAILED TO CONSIGNORS – approximately 10 days before sale
